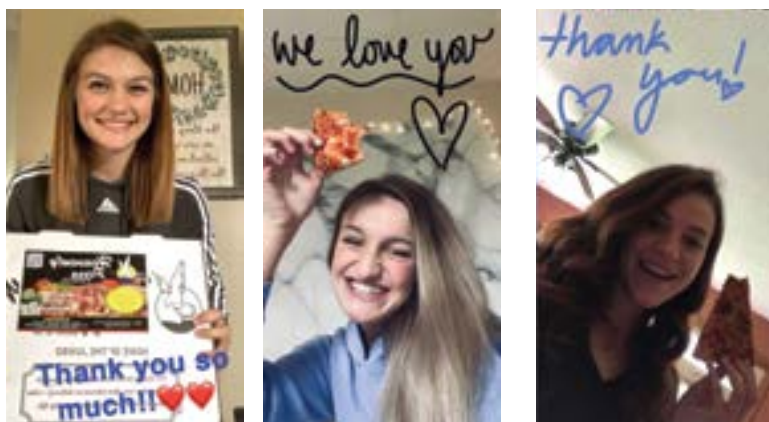

BOARD OF TRUSTEES

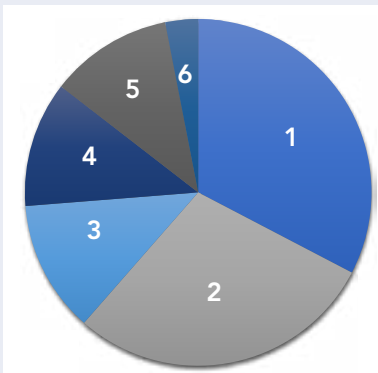


ALLEN EIRY SENIOR CENTER
