

THE JEAN E. EGBERT MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP



Application Guidelines

The Jean E. Egbert Memorial Scholarship Fund has been established in honor and recognition of Jean E. Egbert, a long-time teacher of social studies, economics, and government at Tiffin Columbian High School. Jean was particularly passionate about teaching her students how to think critically about their role in society and pursuing excellence in education. This scholarship will be awarded to a student attending Tiffin Columbian High School who will be participating in a program to pursue advancement in the areas of leadership, government, or public policy. The recipient will be the person who has best demonstrated, in the judgment of the scholarship trustees, a strong interest in studying one or more of the following: 1) government institutions; 2) the mechanisms by which policy decisions are influenced, made and implemented; 3) how those decisions ultimately affect the larger local, state, national, or international community; 4) the burdens and privileges of citizenship; and/or courses related to economics or leadership training programs.

It is expected that scholarships will be awarded annually. Unfortunately, it will not be possible to fund everyone who applies, but it is expected that all grants will be made on the basis of financial need and exceptional merit, and you will need to be able to demonstrate in your application your commitment to achieving your goal.

The scholarship committee will consist of a representative of the Jean E. Egbert family; a representative of the Tiffin community; and a member of the Columbian High School faculty. No information except that contained on or relating to the application is used in the selection process. The scholarship trustees may verify information presented in the applications.

A typed essay of approximately 500 words describing your future goals related to a possible career and why this field might interest you the most shall be submitted with the attached application form. All students who are currently enrolled in grades 9-11 at Tiffin Columbian and whose primary residence is in Seneca County may apply.
