

Dorothy Roush Scholarship Scholarship Details and Forms

An annual scholarship will be awarded to a graduating Hopewell-Loudon senior who has been accepted to an institute of higher education and seeking an associate or baccalaureate degree.

Criteria for selection:

Applicant

- should not be a student receiving a significant amount of their education covered by other scholarships
- must have a minimum grade point average of 2.8
- needs two teacher recommendations using attached forms
- must complete attached application and write an essay
- should be pursuing a career in education or nursing.

Preference may be given to a student planning to be a Language Arts teacher.

If the guidance counselor or the treasurer receives word that the student awarded this scholarship will be receiving full tuition payment (a full ride), then this scholarship shall be withdrawn. If another student has applied and meets the qualifications, he or she may be awarded the money.

A scholarship check will be issued to the university of attendance upon submission of a fall schedule of attendance or a class invoice and verification that the student is attending classes.

The Scholarship committee should consist of the high school guidance counselor and a language arts high school and/or language arts middle school teacher.

The selection committee will not see your name.
