Application Guidelines

The John and Janet Steinmetz Family Scholarship Fund was established at The Tiffin Community Foundation in 2013 by the Steinmetz Family to show their interest and commitment to Hopewell-Loudon education. This scholarship is awarded annually to a qualified, graduating senior of Hopewell-Loudon School.

This scholarship is awarded to a graduating Hopewell-Loudon senior who is pursuing a post secondary degree at a college or university of their choice. The recipient will be a well-rounded student maintaining at least a 3.0 grade point average and shall participate in extra-curricular activities and community service. Further considerations shall include academic perseverance, personal attitude, character and financial need.

Scholarships in the amount of \$1000 will be awarded annually. This scholarship may be used for tuition, books and fees.
