Application Guidelines

Purpose:

To recognize a Columbian High School graduating senior or seniors who have worked to the best of his/her ability to achieve excellence in the tradition of Tiffin Columbian and its alumni.

Criteria:

The following criteria will be used to select the award recipient(s):

1. Must be a senior student at Tiffin Columbian High School.
2. Must be pursuing additional education as recognized by a valid accrediting agency. Attendance must be on a full or part-time basis and within one year of their graduation from Tiffin Columbian.
3. Must have a cumulative GPA above 2.8
4. Must have exhibited good citizenship standards within the school and community.
5. Some preference may be given to a person with financial needs.

Payment:

This scholarship is a one-time nonrenewable award for up to \$1000. This will be applied directly to recipient's account at the college or university he/she will be attending in the fall upon verification of enrollment and established account.

(Please note if there are no candidates who merit the award, no scholarships will be presented.)
