
TCF MISSION STATEMENT

NEW FUNDS OPENED IN 2022

THE TIFFIN WOMEN IN ACTION FUND (TWIA)

This fund, formerly Tiffin Y-Wives, was established to better serve the Tiffin community by expanding their focus to the women and children of the entire community. TWIA recently awarded their first grant to Giving Birthdays. Board member from Giving Birthdays, Jenni Zaika accepted the \$1000 donation at the April 26th meeting. Zaika explained the money will be used



for gifts for Seneca County children in foster or kinship care.



THE SUTTON BANK CHARITABLE FOUNDATION FUND will provide grants and/or scholarships for qualified charitable and educational requests primarily in Seneca County. A progressive, privately held independent, community bank, Sutton Bank was founded in 1878, and still today, remains committed to meeting the financial needs of the community.

THE WSJ REINEKE FAMILY FUND is a donor-advised fund established to support the charitable giving of Bill Reineke and his family in Tiffin and Seneca County. State Senator Reineke and his daughter Suzie are business partners in Reineke Family Dealerships, a three-generation family business, that has grown to include 10 dealerships and over 400 full and part time employees. Bill is a 38-year resident of Tiffin. He and daughters Suzie and Jacquelin have been very committed to supporting the growth and development of the local community.





THE HERB THIBODEAU SCHOLARSHIP FUND

has been established to honor the memory of the man who dedicated 50 years of his life to bowling. Herb Thibodeau

worked tirelessly to advance the sport of bowling, not only in Fostoria, but in the State of Ohio and the entire United States. He was a husband, father, coach, mentor, employer, team member, friend, host and leader in his community. It was Coach Thibodeau who worked to get bowling recognized as a letter sport. He was also responsible for the creation of the greater-Fostoria area High School bowling program and the creation of the Fostoria, Lakota, New Riegel and Hopewell-Loudon High School Bowling teams. This fund will provide annual scholarships to area high school bowling team members.



THE SCHWOCHOW-GALLAGHER CHARITABLE FUND has

been established to be funded at a later date. This fund will provide ongoing funding for the support of agriculture

and environmental charitable, educational, and scientific purposes in Northwest Ohio.

How a Fund is Created



A permanent charitable or educational fund may be created by entering into a fund agreement with The Tiffin Community Foundation, or by naming The Tiffin Community Foundation as beneficiary in your Will or Trust, and describing your fund and it's purpose in that document. To date, we have over 100 component funds that have been created by individuals, families, businesses, nonprofit, and other organizations. A minimum \$15,000 contribution can begin now to grow into a source of funding for the future. The investment of endowment funds is managed to achieve maximum earnings. All funds are created and maintained as separate funds. However, because of the total of foundation assets, investment charges are greatly reduced. All correspondence, accounting, federal and state reporting that is required is done by the foundation. Investment statements are sent to fund donors quarterly.


