

Hopewell-Loudon Alumni Scholarship



Application Guidelines

The **Hopewell-Loudon Alumni Scholarship Fund** was established at The Tiffin Community Foundation in 2025 by members of the Hopewell-Loudon Class of 1979 on behalf of the school's Alumni to demonstrate their ongoing commitment to students receiving their education at Hopewell-Loudon School.

These scholarships are awarded annually to qualified graduating seniors of Hopewell-Loudon School who exemplify the tradition of excellence upheld by Hopewell-Loudon Alumni. Recipients must have a minimum 2.0 grade point average and demonstrate leadership through participation in school activities, volunteer or community service, or employment. Additional considerations include future plans, honors and recognition, special circumstances, and two reference letters that highlight the applicant's leadership qualities.

Two \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded each year. The scholarship funds may be used for tuition, books, or fees related to education or training.

A Selection Committee, composed of Hopewell-Loudon Alumni, parents of former students, and local business leaders, will review the anonymized applications using a weighted scoring matrix to determine award recipients.
